I "celebrated" birthday number thirty-five recently. I've never been big on birthday celebrations. Part of that is because I don't like all of the attention.

The other part is that birthdays remind me of my mortality. This year's birthday was no exception.

We moved to Sullivan 9+ years ago. Since that time, I've learned two things very deeply... things that no one taught me would come with being a Pastor.

First, I never knew I would come to love so many people so deeply. Being a Pastor is not a job, it's so much more than I can put into words.

Second, I had no idea I could learn to love the town I live in the way that I do. Sullivan is such a wonderful place to live, filled with so many amazing people.

You see, birthdays remind me of the loss I have seen and experienced in my lifetime, especially these last nine years. I never would have dreamed that by my mid-thirties both of my parents would be gone. This is a reality that I struggle with all too often.

This year's birthday started out so much like many others. A reminder that life is all too short as we all mourn the death of four lives ending too soon, too suddenly. My heart hurts for these families.

Things began to look up on the day of my birthday. So many people called, texted, or sent a card. People whom I've come to love these past nine years. Some of which who have become so much like family! It truly was one of the better birthdays I've had because of these people.

But then comes another death... our community faces another significant loss. Another life ended too soon.

I didn't have the chance to get to know Megan (Buxton) Thompson. She was starting college at Lincoln as I was finishing. When we moved to Sullivan, I realized this was her hometown and her family was a beloved part of this community.

So today I grieve the loss of another wonderful human being whose life impacted so many of the people I love.

But as my life goes on, I'll continue to do my best to love each person I meet extravagantly because that is how God loves me.


