Grant's Good News

Two years ago, I led a class that spent an entire year reading through the Bible. It was a long journey, but a fun adventure with people who wanted to grow their knowledge of the Bible. Last fall, I started a class that read through a book titled "What is the Bible?" This class was a great way to challenge many assumptions about the Bible and about Christianity. Together we found spiritual enrichment through the reading and discussion.



Beginning next month, Barry Featheringill and I are starting a class that will focus on spiritual and physical fitness. We're using a curriculum called "Walk/Run for God." The class will introduce participants to the parallels of faith and fitness.

"This study is for everyone," says founder Mitchell Hollis, who started his very first class in January of 2010. Since then, tens of thousands of graduates have completed the 5K Challenge from thousands of churches around the world. Hollis goes on to say, "I've seen seven to seventy-year-olds in the same class. In fact, we encourage the whole family to join in together."

Our class will meet for 11 weeks during the spring, and will culminate with the St. Jude's Dash and Bash 5K. We would love to have a large group join us for this endeavor. It's open to people of all ages and fitness levels. Our meetings are scheduled for Sundays from 2:30-3:30 pm. Each class will have 30 minutes of learning (faith & fitness) and then 30 minutes of physical activity.

Our first meeting is March 1, and we hope you'll join us on this journey toward greater spiritual and physical fitness! This year, the nominating team is looking for:


